Thanks to all who attended our parish Listening Sessions at the end of October. We had an incredible turnout of over 550 people who heard about the proposed models for our planning area.

Three models were proposed for our area which is **Planning Area 8**. Our Planning Area includes, Ascension, Christ, Prince of Peace, Incarnate Word, Most Sacred Heart-Eureka, Sacred Heart-Valley Park, St. Alban Roe, St. Andrew Kim (Korean), St. Anselm, St. Clare, St. Joseph, and St. Paul in Fenton. In all three models, Holy Infant remains a stand-alone parish. There are no mergers proposed for Holy Infant in any of the proposed models. No decisions have been made about the schools in our planning area and the Archdiocese stated this week that changes will be postponed until the 2024-25 school year.

In addition to the Listening Session materials, there is a new **online survey** to get more feedback from parishioners about the proposed models. The survey is anonymous, but there is an option to provide your name. The survey will be open until December 31, 2022 and takes about 10-20 minutes to complete. Once you start the survey, you must finish it at that time. Here is the link to the online survey:

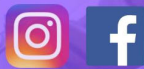
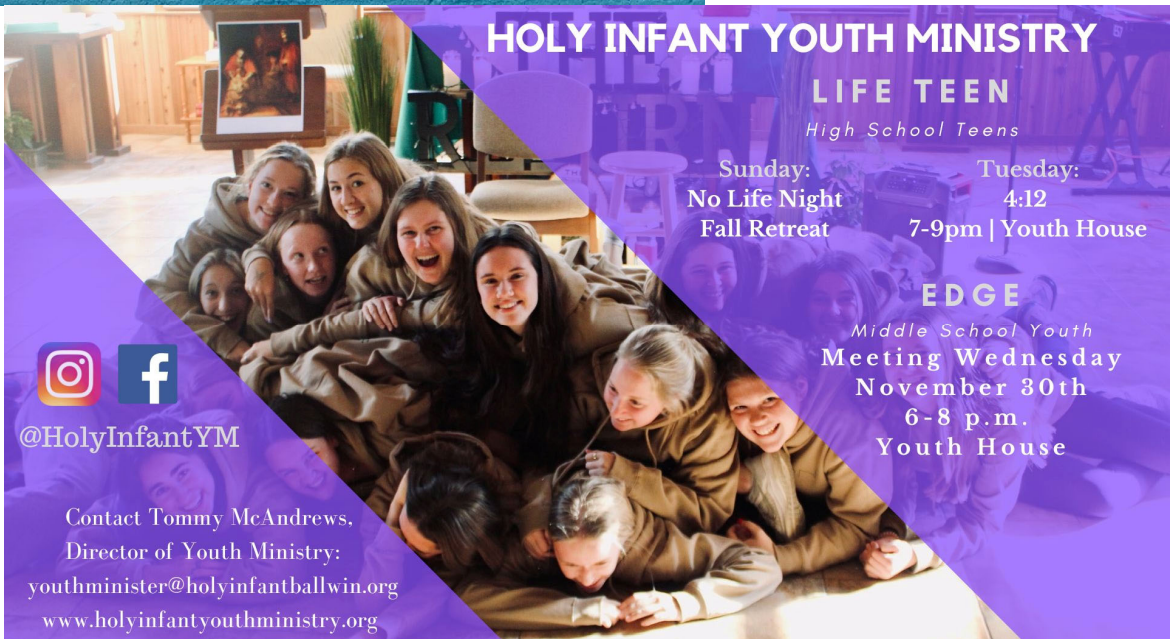

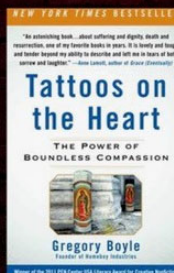
