Dear Confirmation Parents,

This year your child will be receiving the sacrament of Confirmation. It is a big moment in your child's life. Confirmation marks a time when young people are moving on from childhood to the teenage years. It offers young people an opportunity to think about serious choices that are facing them – choices about values, choices about faith. In the coming months, they will be learning a great deal about the core meanings of Confirmation and Christian faith – about a God who loves them for who they are and wants to strengthen them for the challenge of living good and happy lives. Christian faith offers powerful support to young people as they struggle with the great pressures of modern life. But they need every encouragement to hold on to and cherish their faith. While the school and PSR Religion programs are excellent, it needs to be supported both in the home and in the parish. With this in mind, some of our weekend Masses will include a special focus on Confirmation and will involve the Confirmation classes. We will have evenings for sponsors and candidates, a weekend retreat, and many other opportunities for spiritual formation.

Something is special about the way adolescents embrace faith; once they trust, they readily bring their story to the table and allow their lives to be transformed. Something is special about adolescents and Sacraments. Those of us who work with youth, experience these moments as light and hope. The opportunity for conversion and transformation drives us to seek new ways to create communities of trust where youth can share their stories and listen in faith. These hopes are at the heart of our journey to prepare youth to celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation: an opportunity to go deeper, to take another step, to be sealed in love and strengthened for discipleship.

Over the years at Holy Infant, Confirmation small faith groups have played a major part in leading our Confirmande towards the Sacrament. These groups strengthen young disciples and their families and at the same time provide renewal for the faith community. Small faith groups build relationships, giving our candidates an opportunity to grow deeper in their faith in surroundings that support that growth. It allows our candidates to get to know each other better, to bond with one another and begin to understand the concept of building a community of believers who share a common faith. It encourages them to freely talk about their faith, or life struggles and joys in a non-threatening environment.

Our small faith groups consist of candidates from PSR, Day School, and Private School. Groups will meet nine times during the year, once a month or maybe twice, if the group is participating

in a service project. Six of those times would be faith sharing sessions and three times to complete three different types of service projects. The groups are facilitated by trained leaders who are parents of the present eighth grade students. We use Decision Point "Confirmation" by Matthew Kelly to spark conversation in our small faith groups. You can watch the entire program online which may give you a jumping off point for open and frank discussions with your child about faith and life. Each of the small group faith sharing sessions last for two hours.

*The Choice Form will be sent in August by email. Please choose a first, second, and third choice for the small group meetings, and we will try to accommodate you. Get it back to us asap after you receive it.

*The forms are due by Thursday, September 7, or before.

At the Confirmation Parent Evening of Reflection on Thursday, September 21, from 7-8:30 PM in the Upper Cafeteria and Classrooms, you will get a chance to meet your Confirmande's Small Group Leaders who will go over their plan for their small group gatherings and service. If you have any concerns, please contact me; and we will find a way to journey towards the Sacrament of Confirmation that will work for you and your family.

We thank you for your support, encouragement, and prayers for this program. With your help, we feel that it will fulfill its function to strengthen young disciples and their families and provide renewal for the faith community here at Holy Infant.

2.	Have completed the sixteenth year of age, unless the diocesan bishop has established another age, or the
3.	pastor or minister has granted an exception for a just cause; Be a Catholic who has been confirmed and has already received the most holy sacrament of the Eucharist

4.	Not be bound by any canonical penalty legitimately imposed or declared;
