

## New Medicare Cards Coming Soon

Congress has come up with a way to make it harder for Medicare scammers to steal your ID and rip you off – a new Social Security card. It will look like the above picture and will make it considerably harder for criminals to steal your identity. But true to their nature, scammers are already calling people.

\*If you get a phone call asking for your Social Security number and bank information so you can get the new card, hang up! Medicare will never call you and never ask for such information.

\*Or you are asked to pay for your new card, hang up, they are free.

\*Or you are told you'll lose your Medicare benefits if you don't give them money and personal information right now, hang up! The free card will be sent to you automatically and your benefits will remain the same.

It may take time to receive your card and your spouse or friends might receive theirs before you. That is fine. We have until the end of 2019 to begin using the new card and in the meantime the old card will be valid until then.
