RECIPE OF THE MONTH-Lemon Pie

ingredients

4 Large Eggs

1 Lemon

1 1/2 Cups Sugar

1/2 cup Butter Melted

1 teaspoon Vanilla

1 Regular pie crust or a Graham Cracker crust



Directions

- Slice lemon in fourths and remove the seeds.
 Put whole lemon (including the skin) in food processor or Blender and process till chopped fine
- 2. Mix lemon, eggs, butter, sugar & vanilla
- 3. Pour into pie crust
- 4. Bake at 350 for 45 minutes until firm in middle.
- 5. Cool completely and dust with powder sugar if you want.
